James 2:1-10, (11-13), 14-17



The writer of this passage describes the many ways we keep others from our presence. It is followed by a very specific teaching of how we are to treat others in drawing them into our midst.

Is there a possibility that we occasionally prevent others from worshiping with us? What kinds of barriers do we put up in our churches?
